The Psychometrics Forum's Excellence in Psychometrics Award 2021

The Psychometrics Forum is committed to supporting and acknowledging evidence-based practice in Psychometrics. Part of our commitment is to sponsor the **Excellence in Psychometrics Award**. This award recognizes original, useful and validated projects conducted by psychometric practitioners and/or academics.

The Award will be announced in early November, with a virtual presentation being made to the overall winner at our online New Frontiers event on Wednesday 24th November 2021.

The winner will receive The Psychometrics Forum '**Certificate of Excellence Award in Psychometrics**' and a free delegate place at the above online TPF New Frontiers event, at which there will be the opportunity to present your poster to peers over 10 minutes - which will subsequently feature on our Forum website.

The deadline for entry is **Friday, 22nd October 2021**.

Entry requirements

The subject matter of submissions must have taken place within the 3 years preceding the submission deadline and be linked in some way to Psychometrics (i.e. assessment of personality, abilities, motives, values, attitudes or other measures of individual psychological differences). A panel of industry experts will judge submissions, with contributions being welcomed from all fields within the psychometric community.

Poster Submissions via e-mail

Nominees are required to submit an A4 Poster as a pdf document via email plus, an explanatory abstract attachment. In our experience the most helpful of these are 2-page A4 narratives.

Deadline and address for submission

Submissions will be accepted up to and including Friday, 22nd October 2021.
